A. Call to Order

The Regular Board Meeting of the Fellsmere Water Control District (the "District") was called to order at 10:00 a.m.

B. Proof of Publication

Proof of publication was presented showing that notice of the Regular Board Meeting had been published on September 5, 2023.

D. Comments from the Public

The majority of comments by residents related to complaints about the flooding being experienced after rain events, the condition of canals and the public's expectations of being "cleaned out". Also, many residents complained about the need for ongoing and regular road maintenance.

E. Additions or Deletions to Agenda

Mr. Sakuma asked for, and was granted, Board permission to add "Discussion of City of Fellsmere Letter" to New Business. No further additions or deletions to the agenda were offered.

F. Approval of Minutes

1. July 13, 2023, Regular Board Meeting

A **motion** was made by Mr. Carnel,l seconded by Mr. Nelson and passed unanimously approving the July 13, 2023, Regular Board Meeting minutes, as presented.

G. OLD BUSINESS

There were no Old Business items considered.

H. NEW BUSINESS

1. Consider Approval of Agreement Between the Fellsmere Water Control District and A Quality Bushog Services, Inc. for Mowing Services

After Board discussion, a **motion** was made by Mr. Nelson, seconded by Mr. Carnell and passed unanimously approving the Agreement between the Fellsmere Water Control District and A Quality Bushog Services, Inc. for Mowing Services.

2. Discussion Regarding Cost for Repairs to FWCD Infrastructure Due to Storm Events on July 28th and August 17th

Mr. Rich Spzyrka, Indian River County Public Works Director, addressed the Board and explained that, other than those ROW identified in the interlocal agreement, the County would not maintain any FWCD ROW. He indicated the County only responded to emergency requests from residents as a courtesy, not as part of a regular maintenance program.

New Business #4 was taken out of order

4. Discussion Regarding City of Fellsmere Letter Dated September 6, 2023

Mr. Mark Mathes, City Manager of Fellsmere, addressed the Board about several of the ongoing and future projects within the City. A copy of the letter was not available in time for the Board package, but has been saved in the District records.

Board Discussion and Response to Public Comments

The Board thanked members of the public for their comments and advised:

- District Supervisor Tillman and the Engineer will work toward plans to address any necessary actions related to flooding, up to and including emergency contracted services;
- District Board offered to meet with City to address joint activity related to the stormwater system;
- Board advised that the District did not have statutory power to create and maintain roads. The rights of way are for maintenance access to the canals and were not created for public access to residential homes;
- Further coordination between the County, City and District may help address the road maintenance concerns.

3. Discussion Approval of Consulting Agreement between the District and The Vogel Group

After Board discussion, a **motion** was made by Mr. Carnell, seconded by Mr. Tillman and passed unanimously approving the Consulting Agreement between the District and The Vogel Group.

I. ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS

1. Financials

Mr. Sakuma noted the financial report was included in the board package.

2. Water Quality Report

Mr. Sakuma referred to the water quality report included in the board package. He advised the elevated Chloride levels were noted in the canal adjacent to the NSFOA parcel. Mr. Sakuma informed the Board he would work with the Engineer and Attorney for any review and action related to the report, and no Board discussion nor action was necessary.

3. Attorney

Mr. Johnson advised the Board the conversion efforts were ongoing and draft legislation was in process.

4. Manager

Mr. Sakuma was asked by the Board to coordinate efforts with Mr. Tillman and Rod toward addressing the issues raised during public comment.

J. BOARD MEMBER COMMENTS

There were no further comments from the Board.

K. ADJOURN

There being no further business to come before the Board, Mr. Nelson adjourned the Reg	ula
